Kurdish traditional diet includes many plants such as *olives, parsley, coriander, turmeric, cumin, black paper, clove,* and *sumac,* etc., for their culinary uses and therapeutic benefits. In addition, several essential oil-containing plants in the Kurdistan region grow abundantly, such as *rosemary, thymus, pelargonium, rose, chamomile, santolina, mint, lavender, eucalyptus,* etc. Kurdish medicinal plants have been reported for their role and potential in the prevention and treatment of many diseases like olive (psoriasis, diabetes, CVD, etc.), sumac (hypertension), rhubarb (constipation), parsley (kidney stone, anemia), thyme (rheumatism, digestive disorders), walnut (diabetes, antiseptic), fenugreek (diabetes, dyspepsia), nettle (diabetes, cancer), sage (cough), basil (fever, digestive problems), horsetail (diuretic), watercress (diuretic, expectorant), chicory (diabetes), etc.. Besides these medicinal plants, numerous fruits, berries, vegetables, and cereal plants are abundantly growing in Kurdistan contributing to the nutrition and economy of Kurdistan and maintaining the environment. This conference aims to explore the therapeutic benefits of Kurdish medicinal plants, and their contribution to the Kurdish economy and achieving sustainable development goals for God-Health and Well-Being.
